Just like the ways in which we, as tutors, separate paper issues into a hierarchy of global and local issues, we can also order the local issues into priorities.

Clarity

- 1. Word (verb) choice
- 2. Passive voice
- 3. Wordiness/Redundancy
- 4. Vague pronouns (excessive relative pronouns)
- 5. Misplaced modifiers

Grammar

- 6. Fragments/Run-
- 7. Shift in point-of-view
- 8. Tense
- 9. Subject-verb agreement
- 10. Parallel structure

Copy-editing

- 11. Punctuation
- 12. Capitalization



Subordinating elements help fix clarity.

Clause structure helps fix punctuation.
